Membership Requirements

Middletown Dog Training Club is one of the oldest dog clubs in the southern Ohio area. The high standards and professionalism of the members have made MDTC the center point of the community for over 50+ years in Middletown. Members help the organization moving forward by remembering our past and incorporating new programs and training methods for the future.

Club Requirements

1. Complete two of the following classes: Puppy, Obedience 1, Obedience 2, Rally-O or Submit a Performance Title that you have received in the last 5 years.
2. Pay annual dues of \$50 Single/\$65 Family/\$15 Junior (under 16 years old).
(after July 1 to Dec 31 - \$25 Single/\$27.50 Family/\$7.50 Junior)
3. Complete and submit an application for Board review.
4. Attend the next Member meeting to be voted in.

Once Accepted

1. The member(s) will be required to volunteer 12 hours per year to the operation of the club (example: helping set up for classes/orientation, assisting with classes, teaching classes, cleaning the building).
2. Members are required to attend 2/3 of the Members meetings per year. Meetings will be held approximately every 6 weeks and will be announced in advance.
3. Help with one fundraiser per year.

Benefits of Membership

Members will receive the vast knowledge of years of training and experience from the trainers and handlers from a broad range of training disciplines including but not limited to Obedience and Conformation.

Other Benefits:

All obedience classes \$35 per session: Puppy, Intermediate Puppy, Obedience 1 & 2, Rally-O, Conformation. Advanced classes \$45 per session.

Become an Instructor:

1. Assist teaching for at least 2 class sessions.
2. Demonstrate knowledge and ability in the field they wish to teach (subject to Board approval).
3. Be able to communicate class instruction and material in a clear, concise, and timely manner.
4. Instructors teaching will receive a free session (Obedience) for each session they teach.
